The Work includes the article and all material to be published within and with the article in any and all media, including but not limited to tables, figures, graphs, source code, movies, and other multimedia. Responses to discussions of the Work, errata, and other similar material directly related to the Work that may arise subsequent to publication also are considered part of the Work. In the event the Work incorporates copyrighted material of others, the Authors warrant that all required permissions or releases have been secured. Authors agree to indemnify, defend, and hold EEGS, its directors, officers, employees, and agents harmless against any claims to the contrary.

Authors warrant that the Work is an original work and has not been published elsewhere in whole or in part (except in abstract form), that it is only submitted to JEEG, and that it will not be submitted elsewhere pending written notice of acceptance or rejection by EEGS. Authors warrant that the manuscript contains no libelous or unlawful statements and does not infringe on the rights of others.
